- **3.** Any performances must be original material or in the public domain (free of copyright and/or royalty free).
- 4. All entries must be submitted through YouTube using the #OptimistMusicalHappiness2021 no later than March 15, 2021. Also, email the YouTube link to programs@optimist.org and in the subject line write #OptimistMusicalHappiness2021 and include the attached form. The Musical or Vocal submission shall be no longer than three minutes.
- 5. At the International level, 1st place in each category will receive a \$250 scholarship; 2nd place in each category will receive a \$150 scholarship and 3rd place in each category will receive a \$100 scholarship.
- 6. The winners will be announced on the International Day of Happiness on March 20, 2021.



This exciting new program is designed to encourage and celebrate youth Musical and Vocal categories. Scholarships will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place at the OI level for each category.
